**Southern Cross**  
Jižní kříž

The flag has four red stars and Union Jack (the UK flag). Four stars represent Southern Cross

New Zealand is a country in the south-west of the Pacific Ocean, consists of 2 large islands: - North Island - South Island.  
The Tasman Sea separates New Zealand from Australia.  
The capital is Wellington


The early Polynesian settlers called the country *Aotearoa*, which means *Land of the Long White Cloud*.  
New Zealand is a long way from any other country.  
New Zealand is not a crowded country. There are more sheep than people there. Most people live on North Island in the capital, Wellington or in Auckland.

Maoris have a special dance called the *Haka*. They stick the tongue out to frighten their enemies.

The original people of New Zealand, are called *Maoris*.

New Zealand was discovered by a Dutch explorer Abel Tasman in 1642.

The country is hilly with rocks, volcanoes, hot springs, mud pools and geysers and evergreen forests. The highest peak is Mr. Cook.

New Zealand has three official languages ENGLISH, MAORI and NEW ZEALAND SIGN LANGUAGE.  
Sign Language - znaková řeč.

The national sport is rugby. New Zealanders are very proud of their national rugby team, the *All Blacks*. The team gets its name from the fact that it plays in black shirts, shorts and socks.
